Mely Caballero-Anthony is an Associate Professor at the S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS), Singapore and Head of the RSIS Centre for Non-Traditional Security Studies. She is also the Secretary General of the newly established Consortium on Non-Traditional Security Studies in Asia (NTS-Asia). Her research interests include regionalism and regional security in Asia Pacific, multilateral security cooperation, politics and international relations in ASEAN, conflict prevention and management, as well as human security. At RSIS, she teaches courses on Non-Traditional Security, and Government and Politics in Southeast Asia. She also lectures regularly on special topics related to regionalism and security in Asia-Pacific at the SAFTI Military Institute (Command and Staff College), Singapore Police Academy and Civil Defence College. Her current publications both single-authored and co-edited include, *Understanding Non-Traditional Security in Asia: Dilemmas in Securitization* (UK: Ashgate, 2006), *Studying Non-Traditional Security in Asia: Trends and Issues* (Singapore: Marshall Cavendish, 2006), *Regional Security in Southeast Asia: Beyond the ASEAN Way* (Singapore: ISEAS, 2005); *UN Peace Operations and Asian Security* (Routledge, 2005). She has also published extensively on a broad-range of security issues in Asia Pacific which appeared in peer-reviewed journals and a number of book chapters. Dr Anthony is also on the editorial board of *The Pacific Review* and newly established journal *Global Responsibility to Protect (GR2P)*.
